Subject Specific Vocabulary

Christian	A person who follows the religion of Christianity.
Hindu	A person who follows the religion of Hinduism.
Humanist	People who follow non-religious beliefs.
karma	Hindu and Buddhism belief that the sum of a person's actions in this and previous states of existence
salvation	Being saved from danger, loss or harm.
reincarnation	A person or animal in whom a particular soul is believed to have been reborn.
judgement	The ability to make considered decisions or come to sensible conclusions
bereavement	A period of mourning after a loss, especially after the death of a loved one.
ceremony	A formal religious or public occasion.
liturgies	A form or formulary according to which public religious worship is conducted.
