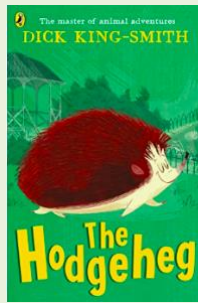

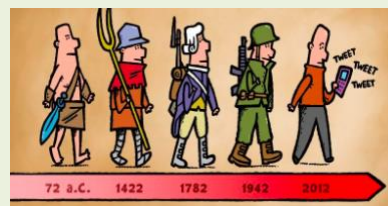
### Geography
