## Communication and Language

- ·Understand how to listen carefully and why listening is important.
- ·Learn new vocabulary.

- Develop overall body-strength. balance, co-ordination and agility.
- Further develop and refine a range of ball skills including: throwing, catching, kicking, passing, batting, and aiming.
- Develop their small motor skills so that they can use a range of tools competently, safely and confidently. Suggested tools: pencils for drawing and writing, paintbrushes, scissors, knives, forks and spoons.
- Use their core muscle strength to achieve a good posture when sitting at a table or sitting on the floor.
- Further develop the skills they need to manage the school day successfully:
  - lining up and queuing
  - mealtimes
