Phonics:

In Phonics this week, we will be learning the following digraphs: ur (fur), ow (owl), oi (boing) and the trigraph : ear (hear). We will be revisiting the 'tricky' words: **was, they, you** & learning **my, by, all**. We will be writing: **turn, hurt, my, town, now, down, how, by, join, boil, all, hear, near, into.**


What we are learning:

Our learning this week is based on the narratives 'Dinosaur Roar' and 'Katie and the dinosaurs.' We will be extending our vocabulary by exploring opposites. We will be making predictions and talking about what we have heard to develop our comprehension skills. We will be using full sentences to talk about what we have learnt and writing a sentence by segmenting the sounds in words.

In maths, we are learning to compare lengths using the language 'longer than' and 'shorter than.' We will also be researching the lengths of some of the dinosaurs.
