Phonics:

In Phonics this week we will be learning the digraphs 'sh, th, ng, nk' where 2 letters make one sound. We will be learning the 'tricky' words: she, he and of. We will be revisiting: is, as, has, her, and, his, into, to, no, go, the. We will be spelling: fix, fill, jam, leg, bell, dad, mess, bag, wet, duck.

What we are learning:

Our learning this week is based around the fiction book 'Whatever Next.' We will be making predictions, looking at the illustrations in detail and exploring vocabulary.

We will be working together to write a postcard from Little Bear on the moon and writing a list of food to take on a picnic in space.

In maths, we will be learning to describe four sided shapes and looking at similarities and differences between them. We will be ordering space rockets from the shortest to the longest making sure that the ends are level for accurate measuring.
