


## Key Vocabulary

Key Word	Definition
<b>Industry</b>	The work of turning raw materials into products in factories.
<b>Industrial Revolution</b>	The change from making things by hand to using machines in factories. A time of scientific and technical modernisation.
<b>Imperialism</b>	Taking control of other countries to gain more power, wealth and influence.
<b>Colonisation</b>	When a country takes control of others in order to control the area and gain riches.
<b>Empire</b>	A group of countries ruled by one single ruler or state.
<b>Steam power</b>	Engines powered by heated water to create steam.
<b>Pollution</b>	Putting harmful materials into the air or environment.
<b>Sanitation</b>	Keeping places free from dirt, infection, disease and sewerage.
