You may have seen on Dojo that Mr Morgan has talked about a zoom meeting for each class.

As stated by Mr Morgan, we need to establish some ground rules for the meeting:

- The meeting link must not be shared or publicised on social media. This is a private meeting.
- Your children are encouraged to attend with you, but children are not permitted to attend on their own.
- Please be mindful of the background. Please do not zoom from a bedroom.
- Ensure that children are appropriately dressed.
- Recordings or photographs are not permitted.
- You must be with your child at all times.
- We prefer parents to show their faces, however, we respect your decision if you don't want to.
- If the screen is turned off the name must match the person in attendance (not the name of the phone), from now on, muted screens and anonymised names will be removed from the online meeting. This is to protect everybody.
- Please demonstrate Kings Road's school values and behave in a courteous and polite manner.
- This meeting is only for XX children and parents. Siblings will have their own meeting.
- If you are not able to attend, then please let me know via a Dojo message. I will be contacting parents by phone who do not get back to me. If I can't get through via a phone call, I will be conducting a doorstep visit as we just want to check in to see how things are going.
- This Code of Conduct is an addendum to our Online Safety Policy and action will be taken in accordance with this policy, should there be a breach of the agreed conduct. - By joining a King's Road Zoom call, you are agreeing to abide by this Video Conferencing Code of Conduct. - Whilst we have taken measures to ensure the forum is as secure and safe as possible, we cannot guarantee this.

This is an opportunity to check in with school and speak to each other. It is not the place to teach the children but is a discussion area open to all. You may have questions to ask and we will do our best to answer your questions in full.
