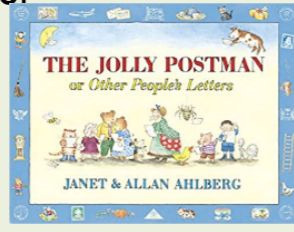
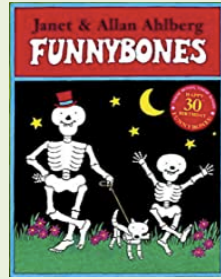

Living in the wider world

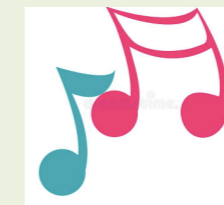
Children will gain an understanding and build skills for being in the wider world outside of school by:

We are learning to sing nursery rhymes.



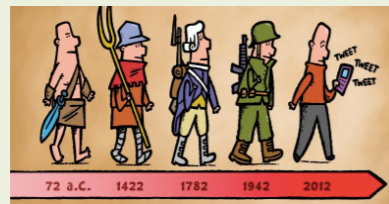
Geography
