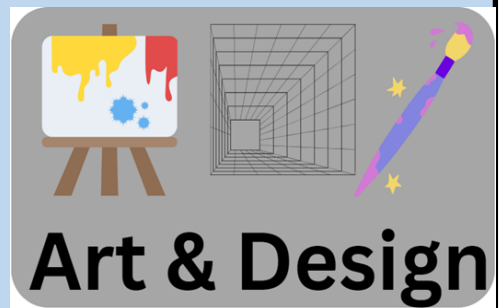

<i>Painting</i>	<i>A picture made using paint.</i>
<i>Realism</i>	<i>A style of art that tries to make objects and people look as real as possible.</i>
<i>Post-impressionism</i>	<i>Artwork which focuses on colours and tones rather than making things look real.</i>
<i>Jungle</i>	<i>An area of tropical rainforest covered with vegetation and home to wild animals like lions, elephants, gorillas and</i>
<i>Botanical gardens</i>	<i>Gardens which are home to a range of different plant species. People can visit and learn about different plants.</i>
<i>Portrait Art</i>	<i>an image of a person or animal.</i>
<i>Landscape Art</i>	<i>An image of an outdoor scene which might include land, water, clouds and sunlight</i>

Key Knowledge

- Henri Rousseau was a French painter who lived between 1844-1910.
- He attended boarding school and found most of his subjects hard.
- At school, he won prizes for drawing and for music.
- He was known for his jungle paintings.
- He never actually saw a jungle in real life so he used his imagination and his visits to the zoo to inspire him.
- His style was called post-impressionism.
