

Prime areas of learning:

Communication and Language ELG 1/2/3

- **New Vocab** – digger, truck, travel, transports, tickets, timetable.
- Role play driving vehicles and paying to use different transport.
- Discuss where we may travel to and on what type of transport.
- Talk about an imaginary journey that we would like to go on.
- Go on welly walks and talk about what we have seen, heard, smelt etc.
- Sing wheels on the bus, we're going on a bear hunt.

Physical development ELG 4/5

- Obstacle course Outdoor
- Using children's ideas of transport - ask them to "move like a train" etc.
- Traffic light games.
- Different journeys following road signs - one way/go/stop/ no entry.
- Moving toys to make different tracks in the sand/mud.
- Can you make different size footsteps?
- Going on a 'Bear Hunt' around the school.
- Learning to Ride a bike,

Personal, social and emotional development ELG 6/7/8

- Look at road safety and how to cross the road, especially when out on a Welly walks.
- Discuss where we may travel to and on what type of transport. Talk about an imaginary journey Health and Eco ways of travelling and moving.
- Talk about where we might have travelled to.
- Do you to travel to see people in your family.
- Different people who make up your family.



Specific areas of learning:

Literacy ELG 9/10

- **Text ideas** – We're going on a bear hunts, The hungry Caterpillar, The Journey home from Grandpa's, Little Red Riding Hood - Traditional Tales.
- Alphabet-journey - using initial sounds etc.
- Story making- riding on a magic carpet.
- Recount of a journey. Where would you like to go?

Mathematics ELG 11/12

- Weighing different objects that move- estimating how much vehicles weigh.
- Tally charts of their favourite ways to move.
- Time - journeys long/short.
- Money - costs of tickets/journey.
- Numbering cars and garages for maths activities.
- Explore shapes through moving vehicles - use a real bicycle - find shapes to explore how it moves.

Understanding the world ELG 13/14/15

- Environmental sounds, discuss woodlands, towns, cities etc.
- My journeys to school - take your pencil for a walk and draw things they see on the way.
- Finding out about how different vehicles move and work.
- Animal journey - bird migration.
- What jobs do different vehicles do?

Expressive arts and design ELG 16/17

- Create different forms of transport using different resources i.e. construction, junk materials.
- Making different tyre print pictures.
- Design a new logo for an aeroplane.
- Make paper aeroplane s
- Through Dance moving like different transport.
