Having navigated Christmas, the New Year and Storm Goretti, it has been brilliant to be back and seeing everyone. I've had lots of children through my door showing me their work; the one value we reward and reinforce above all others is effort and it has been clear that children have been determined to demonstrate it. On the window in my office I write the names of those who come to visit in chalk markers and today I ran out of space! I have been trying to improve my own handwriting in cursive script, but I often find the children's has surpassed mine and they give me tips on how to do better. Joshua in Year 3 advised me not to worry and that I'd improve if I kept trying.

I read an extract from Annabel's writing that she shared with me. She put herself in the position of a refugee who had just arrived.

Out of fear, I held my backpack as if it was my only friend.

Thoughtful, poignant and really lends perspective. When children think so deeply and compassionately it underscores just how meaningful this work is and what a genuine privilege it is to be part of their journey.


