Our Learning

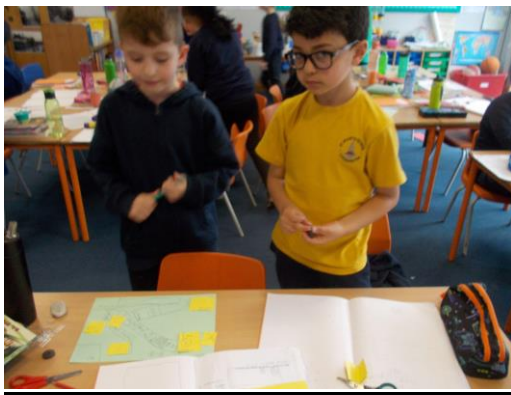
Maths - We have started our time unit. The children have been learning to tell the time using a 24 hour clock and find the duration of events. In our KIRFs we are learning the 4 times table multiplication and division facts.

English

We are continuing reading 'The Pebble in my Pocket'. This week we used drama, freeze frame technique to imagine what it was like 300, 155, 67 and 65 million years ago. Then we created a fact file about dragonflies.

Science
