<u>Important Update: Free School Meals & Uniform Grant – What Parents Need to Know</u>

All primary school children in Wales now receive Universal Free School Meals automatically – no application needed for your child to eat at school. However, **you still need to apply** for means-tested Free School Meals if you receive certain benefits. Why?

✓ Up to £200 per child in School Essentials Grant – for uniform, shoes, stationery, and more













- **Extra funding for our school** helps us provide better resources and support for all pupils
- ☑ Eligibility for other support including help with trips, IT equipment, and enrichment activities

Even if your child gets a free meal already, **applying ensures your family and our school don't miss out**.

Who Can Apply?

You may be eligible if you receive:

- Income Support
- Income-based Jobseeker's Allowance
- Income-related Employment and Support Allowance
- Universal Credit (with annual net income under £7,400)
- Child Tax Credit (without Working Tax Credit, and income under £16,190)
- Support under the Immigration and Asylum Act
- Pension Credit (guarantee element)
