## SAFER INTERNET DAY

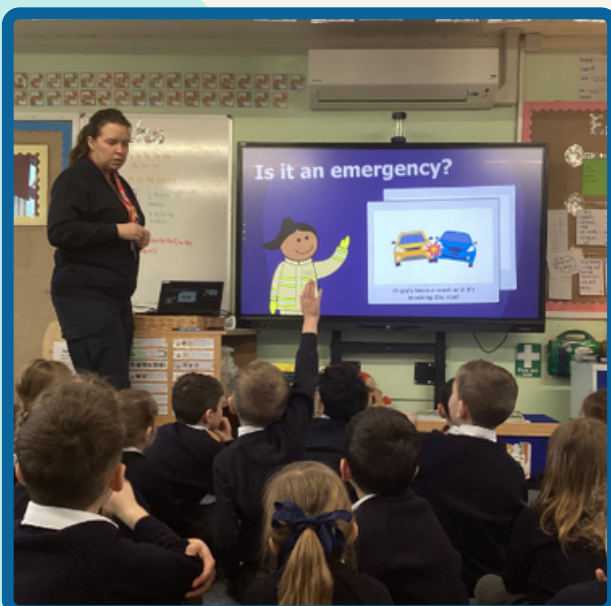

Ideas for inspiration...

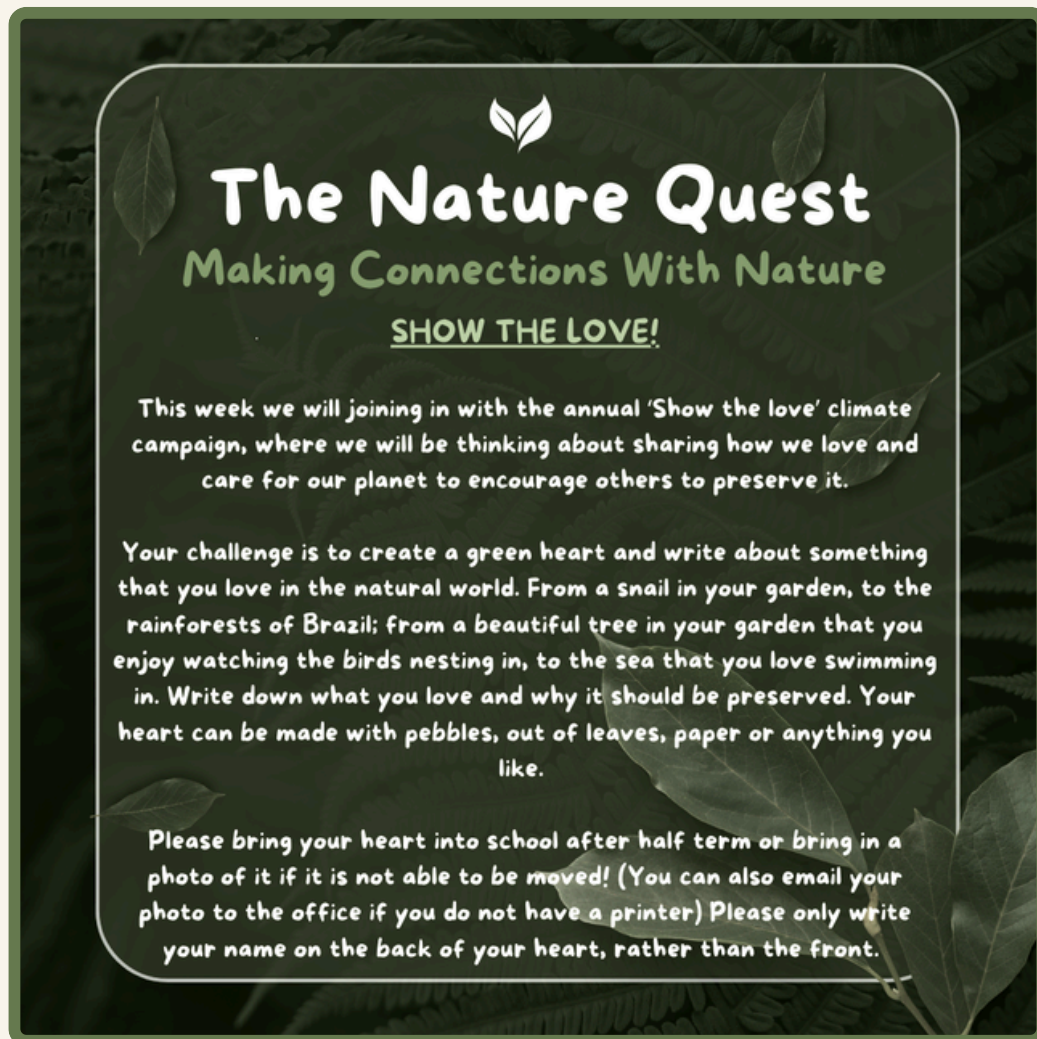
Harry Potter + Matilda = A blue dress plus books with a magic wand and round glasses
