Welcome back!

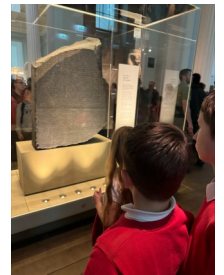

The year 5's had a wonderful time at the British Museum, and were able to experience all of the many Ancient Egyptian artefacts in the galleries. Seeing the Rosetta Stone was a real highlight and brought the children's learning to life. During the 'mummy workshop' led by an expert, children learnt about the mummification process and were able to witness specialist scans of some of the mummies displayed, including the famous Ginger... do ask your children about him! Their behaviour and engagement was exceptional. Well done year 5's.



Year 4 had an amazing day this week with our children learning about the Vikings and their lives. Throughout the morning, the children made a variety of Viking artefacts, which were inspired by the different jobs the Vikings would have carried out. These ranged from creating runes, amulets, medicinal cures and making candles, to name but a few. They were amazed by the range of activities, as well as the information they learnt. During the afternoon, they became archaeologists and used brushes to extract the objects from the soil, before identifying and finding a use for them and then creating their own museum. A demonstration was then performed showing the children how to create an amulet using melted pewter. A huge thank you to all our parents who very kindly assisted with the day to ensure it was a success.

Thank you to all who supported our Fireworks event. The PTA organised another amazing evening of fireworks, food, glowsticks and drinks. We had lots of compliments. Thanks to everyone who gave up their time to help and to those who bought tickets. Have a great weekend.
