Thank you to all the parents who attended Parent Forum meetings this week. It is a pleasure to share the exciting things we are doing at school and to hear parents' views and ideas for further improvement.

In each of the three meetings held this year, one topic has been raised consistently: safety at pick-up and drop-off times. Many members of our school community are worried about this, and you will remember that I have mentioned it many times through this newsletter. #### Year Three

In Year Three we have started a new Science topic learning about rocks. In our lesson this week, we carried out a hands-on investigation. The children had lots of fun being scientists; they used a nail, sandpaper, a plastic spoon and a wooden lolly stick to test the hardness of rocks, including sandstone, chalk and granite. The children made observations and recorded their findings, using them to rank the rocks in order from softest to hardest.
