

ART CRAFT & DESIGN

Art & Design focuses on traditional techniques and processes including drawing, painting, printmaking and mixed media. You will be taught through a series of practical workshops and focused projects before working on a Personal Investigation of your choice.

PHOTOGRAPHY

GRAPHICS

Graphics focuses on a variety of graphic and design areas. You will learn a variety of handmade and digital techniques and processes including illustration, typography, branding and multi media. You will be taught through a series of practical workshops and focused projects before working on a Personal Investigation of your choice.
