

Consolidating:

This week's **ENGLISH**

Grammar: continuing with conjunctions (and, so, because, when) and apostrophes for possession e.g. Mrs Plumb's jacket, Mrs Armitage's dog

Writing: Identifying adverbs and applying them in our writing e.g. happily, quickly, joyfully, carefully
