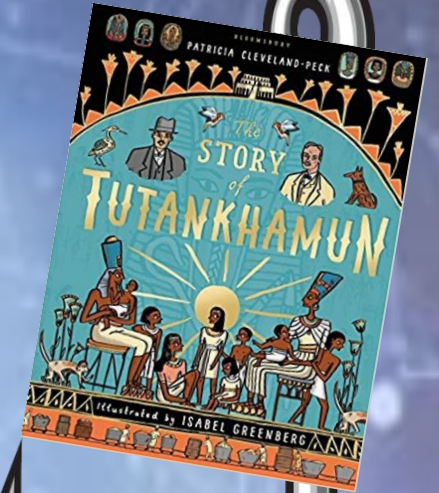


Ancient Egypt – Autumn 1

Subject Specific Vocabulary	
River Nile	A geological feature in Egypt visible from space.
tomb	A large vault for burying the dead.
Pharaoh	The supreme ruler of all of Ancient Egypt
Shaduf	A tool used to gather water from the River Nile
hieroglyphics	A type of writing that used a combination of pictures and symbols
artefact	An object of cultural or historical interest
papyrus	A plant that grew on the banks of the Nile. It was used as an early version of paper
sarcophagus	A large stone box that held a mummy's coffin. Often richly decorated for Pharaohs
Civilisation	A group of people with their own language and way of life
Settlement	A place where people live or establish a community
