Oaklands History of student progress tracking

- 2015/ 2016 Oaklands began the transition from National curriculum levels to I Can statements of achievement for all subjects.
- Summer of 2016 Key stage 2 end of year assessment changed for those students working below age-related expectations
- September 2016 –2021 leavers joined the school with attainment data in the form of Interim Pre-Key stage standards. The Interim pre-key stage standards stayed in place for three years, and then they were replaced in 2019 by the pre-key stage standards following the Rochford review recommendations.
- We use the DFE's Secondary accountability document for guidance in measuring progress.

Reporting Progress in 2024

In the absence of a national comparison, we have used a challenging flight path estimation for all students in English and Maths. To do this, we have been guided by previous national expectations and the guidance for students working below age-related expectations. This has enabled us to see the percentage of students meeting their flight path expectations in English and Maths. As a comparison for Science we have also used the Mathematics flight path information to analyse the results. No other subjects are formally assessed at Key stage 2, and therefore we are unable to do this calculation for other subjects. We will, however continue to monitor the progress in all subjects as detailed in our assessment policy.
