Breakfast Club: The free breakfast club runs from 8.15am until 8.45am, although food service ends at 8.35am as does the last admission, in order for the children and staff to tidy up and get the children ready for going into class. From 8.35am children will need to wait with their parent in the usual way until the classrooms doors are opened at 8.45am. Please remember to book in with the QR code if you would like your child to attend the free breakfast club.

Please send your child into school wearing a **T-shirt in the colour of their team**. If you are unsure of their team colour please speak to your child's class teacher. Children will also need to wear their **black PE shorts and trainers**. They will wear this for the whole day.

Arrangements for the day

KS2 Parents are invited to stay in the playground after dropping the children off at 8:45. The children will be registered as usual in their classrooms and will be brought onto the field, ready to start the events at 9:15. KS1 parents will be invited through the KS2 side gate at 1:15pm. Both sports days will be held on the **KS2 field**.

We kindly ask that parents remain behind a fenced-off area while the children complete a carousel of activities, as this allows the children to enjoy all of the activities without too much distraction and will ensure a smooth transition between events. During the events the PTA will be selling refreshments for parents to buy. We will be giving every child a free ice lolly once the events have finished.



After all classes have completed the carousel of events, they will be participating in races on the KS2 field. At this time, parents will be able to move closer to the race track, but we please ask that you don't come too close to the track so that we can ensure that all children can complete their races safely.

After all the children have raced, we will be having a mums' race and a dads' race (weather permitting). If you would like to participate in these races there will be sign-up sheets on the day. Please sign up while the children are completing the carousel of events. You will not be able to sign up once the class races have begun.

The races will be finished by **12:00 for KS2 and by 3:00 for KS1**. We kindly ask that parents make a swift exit from the school after this time as we will need to get ready for lunch time and home time respectively.
