Mrs Rhoda Brown has joined the year 3 / 4 team as a specialist communication support teacher for those children with hearing impairments, while Mr Parker, Miss Cross and Mr Wardle move to different year groups and demonstrate their superb teaching versatility!

The Belvoirdale Learning HUB

The 2026/2027 Academic Year will see the Cedar classroom renamed the **Belvoirdale Learning HUB**. The HUB will have a small number of permanent pupils while others will be registered in mainstream classrooms and visit the HUB at various times of the day for different activities including maths and English lessons each morning. These children will then return to their mainstream classes in the afternoon.

AFTERNOON 1:00pm to 3:15pm: Up to EIGHTY (80) different children from across KS2 (years 3 to 6) will visit the HUB at various times to access different nurture, wellbeing, educational and social communication activities, that will support their broader life skills. These activities will include practical life skills such as cooking, personal communication skills such as social interaction and friendship and Physical and mental health activities. At all times there will be a qualified teacher with SEND experience, as well as a full time ELSA (Emotional Literacy Support Assistant) and a fully trained and experienced SEND classroom assistant. The teacher and pupil ratio will be greatly reduced to ensure that a personal and bespoke learning experience can be given to those children with wider needs.
