To recite number names to 20. To know doubles up to 5+5

by the end of this half term, children should be able to say the number names in order to 20. The aim is for them to say the number instantly when they see that number. They should also be able to recall the following doubles.

Children should be able to start at one and then count on:

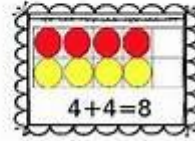
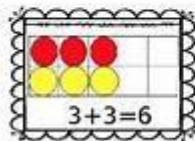
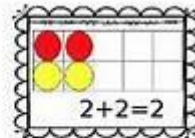
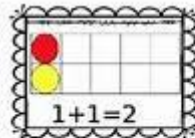
1 2 3 4 5 6 7 8 9 10
11 12 13 14 15 16 17
18 19 20

Ask them to count a set of objects and touch them as they count. Check that they can say one number for one object.

If confident, they could try counting backwards too

Children should know the following doubles automatically:

$1+1=2$
 $2+2=4$
 $3+3=6$
 $4+4=8$
 $5+5=10$
