


Art in context – create images in the style of an artist in history.

Health and Wellbeing

- Children can explain what can affect their health positively and negatively including dental health.
- They can share personal successes and describe how they achieved them.
- They can use vocabulary to describe the intensity of good and bad feelings and discuss ways to manage those feelings.
- They understand how and why they should keep themselves clean.
- They can describe a variety of ways to stay safe in different environments e.g. on the street, in school, on the internet.
- They understand when it is necessary to share secrets with others so they do not put themselves or others at risk .
- They understand when it is necessary to seek help from others and who they can ask for that help.

Music

2 Classes' music lessons will be delivered by Lincolnshire Music Service this term.

- they will use their voice and copy a given scale.
- they will compose simple tunes using a pentatonic scale.
- they will improvise repeated patterns.
- they will take part in two-part harmonies.
- they will perform simple rhythmic and melodic patterns on an instrument to accompany a song.

Geography


