**What are the expectations for planning? Is there a set format?**

There is no specific format for history planning, however each unit should have a medium term plan, which follows and complements the Long term Plan. This will ensure that the History curriculum is effectively covered across all key stages.  
The overarching Enquiry Question for each unit should be recorded.  
Specific reference to vocabulary, both unit specific and identified substantive concepts should be highlighted within the planning.  
Reference to History Learning Ladders should also be made.

**What are the expectations for assessment? When are assessments due?**

At the end of unit reference should be made to the Enquiry Question and assessment made about the ability of children to discuss/debate the question, making reference to learning taught.

**What are the expectations for marking?**

Timely marking with some evidence of marking to the skills as stated in Learning Ladders  
Dates and timeline errors to be corrected  
Some evidence of 'purple pen' to encourage deeper learning

**Are there any resources that are expected to be used? Where can these be found?**

High quality, factually accurate online resources.  
Eg Historical Association (KS logins on t-drive History), National Archives. Teaching History with 100 objects or education sections from national and local museums.
