100 Not Out-Sir David Attenborough



Friday 8th May marks the 100th birthday of Sir, Sir David Attenborough, the world-famous naturalist, historian and television presenter, who has played such an important part in the cultural lives of British citizens and who has single-handedly changed the way humans understand the world. Born in 1926, David Attenborough studied as a biologist and began a career in television at the age of 28 in a TV programme called *Zoo Quest*. However, David, whose brother Sir Richard Attenborough was a renowned actor and film director, moved into the BBC television corporation for many years and was asked to become the Director General (the big boss). Luckily David knew that this wasn't for him and created one of the most iconic television series that changed the world and people's understanding of the natural world. In 1976, filming began on the series *Life on Earth* and three years later, it became the must-see TV show for 13 weeks. As a child I remember watching this iconic programme with my parents on a Sunday evening and talking about it to my friends in the playground the next day.

Remarkably, Sir, Sir David Attenborough is still a healthy and intelligent man, who remains a leading spokesperson for the environment and the natural world. He is also one of the few people to be knighted twice; once by Queen Elizabeth in 1985 and then again by King Charles in 2022. Thank you Sir, Sir, David Attenborough.

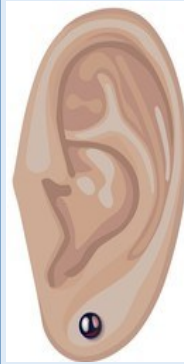
