In English the children have been writing their introduction to their instruction writing 'How to wash a woolly mammoth?' They have been learning how to write a rhetorical question and solution and how to capture the reader's attention. Some idea,

In maths, we continue learning about place value representing numbers to 1000, using the whole-part model and partitioning e.g.  $614 = 600 + 10 + 4$
