We aim for all our children to have good attendance and our target for each child's attendance is 96% or above. Government guidance advises that a child is a Persistent Absentee if they have attendance of 90% or below and action is required to be taken by a school with children and/or families where a child's attendance is nearing or below 90%. We continue to request that holidays are taken during the school holiday. Research shows that reduced attendance impacts children academic and social development.
