## **Entry Requirements:**

You will need a Grade 4 in English Language or English Literature.

# What will I be studying?

In the Level 1/2 Health and Social Care, there are three units- one **examined unit (RO32**) and two **Non-Examined Units (RO33 and RO34**) covered in Year 10 and 11.

Unit RO32:- Principles of care in health and social care settings. Students will learn about different types of settings, the rights of service users in health and social care settings and the benefits to service users' health and well-being when rights are maintained. The application and benefits of person-centred values will be covered as well as the effects on service users' health and well-being if person-centred values are not applied.

**Unit RO33:- Supporting individuals through life events**. Students will learn about Growth and development through a life stage, the impact of life events on individuals and Sources of support.

**Unit RO34:- Creative and therapeutic activities.** The benefits of therapeutic and creative activities are covered and applied in a planned and delivered activity.

## How will I be studying?

Through discussion, group work, individual work, presentations, written coursework, conducting research and exam practice.

#### How will I be assessed?

**Externally assessed unit - RO32**: Principles of care in health and social care settings at **40%** of course mark

**Non-Exam Assessed Units RO33** (Supporting individuals through life events) and **RO34** (Creative and therapeutic activities) at **60%** of course mark. These units are coursework based and moderated.

## Where Next

Level 3 vocational qualifications, such as the Cambridge Technical in Health and Social Care, A-Levels in psychology, biology or sociology and the following apprenticeships; Adult care worker, Allied Health Profession Support, Health and Social Care, Healthcare science assistant, Maternity and Paediatric Support.
