Parent Governor

We are delighted to welcome Mr Duff as our new Parent Governor. He will join our governing body of volunteers. The team work as critical friends to support the strategic direction of the school to ensure the school runs as effectively as possible in order to achieve our school vision.

Science

Our science lead, Mrs Lauren Taylor, carried out a learning walk of science lessons across the whole school yesterday. Children were considering hazards and risk assessing their science topic, testing hypotheses through practical experiments and making links to the science they were learning and real-life jobs.

If you work in an area of science or engineering and would be able to talk to the children about this in one of our assemblies, we would be very interested to hear from you. It really does widen children's understanding about how science is used in different vocations and we certainly have lots of aspiring scientists at Kingsclere!

We have also been successful in gaining a place to take part in a 2-year Science Technology Engineering and Mathematics Hampshire ENTHUSE project which will provide funding and support for staff professional development particularly in science and computing. Well done and thank you to Mrs Taylor for gaining us a place on this programme!

Home Learning

This afternoon, in our Collective Worship Assembly, we celebrated with the children all their achievements in their Home Learning. We are also extremely grateful to you, our parents and carers, for supporting your child's learning beyond the school gates. This includes every time you read with your child, ask them to spell words they are learning, provide a quiet space for them to work and any words of encouragement to support and value their learning. It was fabulous to hear about how creative everyone has been with their 'Take a Pick' tasks – making cakes, building models and even making posters about family trips. There are displays in the classrooms and around the school which you will be able to see when you next visit. Thank you so much for your support! The Education Endowment Foundation research show that children completing 'homework has a positive impact (on children's learning) on average of 5+ months' per year.
