

Our Themes for Autumn Term 2025 in Nursery are: **Marvellous Me, Colours, Autumn & Christmas**

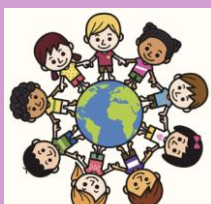


RE: This term we will learn how to make the sign of the cross and our school motto: **LOVE AND LEARN WITH JESUS**. 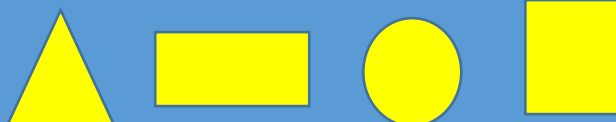


PERSONAL, SOCIAL AND EMOTIONAL DEVELOPMENT.

Induction: Settling in. Making friends. Nursery rules, sharing and turn taking. Circle time- feelings, behaviour, manners.

Maths: Finger rhymes with number. Counting 1-5, saying one number for each object as they count. Reciting numbers beyond 5. Recognising up to 3 objects without counting (subitising). Link numerals and amounts. Explore 2D shapes- names and descriptions (properties). Making comparisons relating to size and height.





PHYSICAL DEVELOPMENT

Fine motor skills development.

Threading, mark making, scissor skills, pouring, using tools
e.g.: tweezers, pipettes.

Gross motor skills development.

Climbing, riding tricycles, moving in different ways, rolling,
balancing and jumping.

Understanding the World:

This term we will be studying...

Colours- recognising colours, using them appropriately
