



Uniform

1. Compulsory Jumper

Jumpers must be purchased from the Proserve and have the college logo. Other jumpers, fleece tops, hoodies or body warmers are not permitted.

2. Compulsory KCC White Polo Shirt with College Logo

White polo shirts must be purchased from Proserve and have the college logo.

3. Skorts

Skorts can be purchased from Proserve. In line with national guidance, other high street alternatives must match the exact specification: grey skort with built in mid-thigh shorts with a minimum length of 16" (excluding waistband). The product code for the Marks & Spencer skort option is: T760322. (Please note that this design is a longer-length skort, approximately 20" long, available for students who wish to purchase this option as opposed to the Proserve skort which is shorter).

4. Trousers / Shorts

Grey formal, tailored trousers or shorts can be purchased from Proserve but can be purchased from any supplier. Skin-tight trousers, jeans or jean/chino-style, leggings or any other style are not permitted. These are available from Proserve but can be purchased from any supplier.

5. Shoes / Boots

Shoes/ankle boots must be black and polishable (not canvas or suede). The shoes/ankle boots must be 100% black with a flat black sole. A selection of acceptable and non-acceptable shoes/ankle boots and brands are contained within this document.

6. Socks

Socks must be black or white. Sports socks with logos are permitted but not if worn over black tights.

7. Tights

Plain tights can be flesh-coloured or black. Students will be asked to remove any white/coloured socks that are worn over black tights that are not 100% black.

8. Outdoor Coat

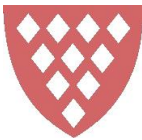
Students should wear a waterproof outdoor coat for college. Coats should be dark in colour, must not have accessories and logos and must be discreet and small in size. Hoodies, fleeces and leather jackets are not permitted.

9. Jewellery and Piercings

Jewellery must be discreet; no excessive jewellery. Students wearing excessive jewellery or belts will be asked to remove the items and hand them in to Student Support for collection at the end of the college day. Nose piercing is acceptable. Earrings can be studs or very discrete hoops touching the earlobe. Nose rings can be studs or very discrete hoops touching the nose. Additional jewellery will be confiscated and returned to students at the end of the day. No other facial piercings are permitted. 1 bracelet, 1 necklace and 1 ring on each hand are permitted.

10. Nails

If nail varnish is worn, then it must be of a neutral colour and nails must be kept at a sensible length.

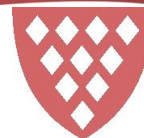

PHYSICAL EDUCATION UNIFORM

All students must have:

- Trainers (based on hygiene, safety and performance, it is strongly recommended that these must be different to students' school shoes)
- **Compulsory** KCC P.E. Top
- Navy shorts
- Navy/red PE socks. The long navy socks are compulsory for football and hockey as students need to wear shin pads. They are also recommended in rugby.
- **Compulsory** Shin-pads for all football and hockey lessons
- Gum shield is compulsory for hockey and strongly recommended for rugby (if possible, this should be designed and fitted by a dentist)
- Football/rugby boots (no fixed studs)
- KCC PE half zip or a fitted plain navy jumper
- Navy/black leggings (must not have a logo)

All students must wear the correct PE uniform. There are additional top layers that are available from Proserve, however they are not compulsory; any plain navy sweatshirt will be acceptable for use in the winter months. These must be completely navy in colour, with no logo or brand and **must not be a hoody. Hoodies are not permitted in college.** An example of an acceptable sweatshirt is as follows:

Students should not bring valuable items with them when they have PE or clubs. It is the student's responsibility to look after items that they bring into college. The changing rooms will be locked during lesson times. Students will need £1.00 coin should they wish to use a locker whilst at the Sports Centre.

If students cannot participate fully due to injury, **they must bring normal PE kit and a warm coat** (when weather is poor) so they can help with organisational duties, coaching and refereeing.

All jewellery must be removed for lessons and clubs, and hair must be tied back.

Any ears that have recently been pierced must have the studs taped over when participating in lessons (students to supply the tape.)

Optional KCC PE UNIFORM

The following items are also available from Proserve and are permitted for PE. A long-sleeved top must be either the quarter zip KCC Jumper, plain navy sweatshirt or a base layer under the PE tee shirt. These must be completely navy in colour, **with no logo or brand and must not be a hoody**. Please see the example of an acceptable sweatshirt. Long trousers must be KCC leggings, KCC training pants or plain navy/black leggings/base layer. **On days where it is raining you may wear a coat at your teachers' discretion.** Students are not permitted to wear slouchy street- style style joggers or tight 'pro-Nike' style shorts.



Below are examples of items that are not allowed in PE (In line with college policy hoodies are not allowed in PE)



Students are expected to attend lessons in full college uniform before changing into PE uniform. If students have had a lunch time club such as dance or Super League then they may stay in PE uniform after their PE lesson.
