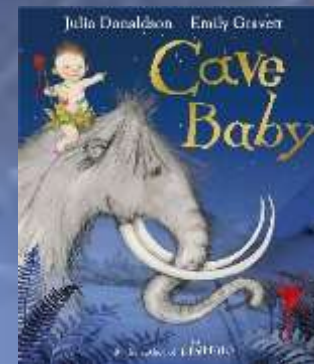


## Subject specific vocabulary

Prehistory	The period of time before written records began
Cave Paintings	A form of communication used by Stone Age people.
Weapons	An item (such as a rock, club or arrow) used to injure, defeat or destroy.
Artefacts	Objects such as ornaments or tools, made by a human being. They are especially historically or culturally interesting.
Neanderthal	A bigger, stronger, but not as smart, early human
Homosapien	A more intelligent form of early human
Hunter-gatherers	People who collect and find food instead of farming.
Roundhouse	A circular house with one room made from wattle and daub
Hillfort	A type of settlement built higher up that had walls and gates

## Back to Basics

- 👑 The earliest humans were hunter-gatherers, surviving by finding animals and other natural products to eat.
- 👑 There were no written records - we use tools, weapons and other artefacts to find out how other people lived.
- 👑 Prehistory is split into three sections: Stone Age, Bronze Age and Iron Age.
