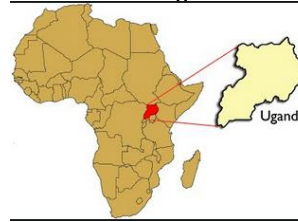

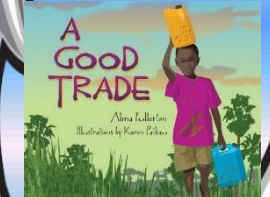
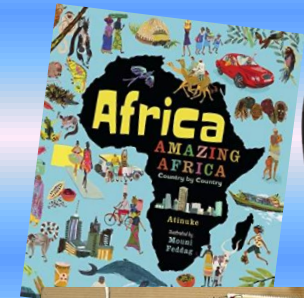
Subject Specific Vocabulary	
continent	a massive, solid area of land that is separated from others by water or other natural features
country	land that is controlled by a single government
Africa	the world's second largest and the second most populated continent
ocean	a huge body of salt water
drought	a continuous period of dry weather
desert	a large area of land that gets very little rain each year
equator	an imaginary circle which divides the earth into the northern and southern hemispheres
season	a part of the year, with different types of weather Most areas of the earth have four seasons.
monsoon	a wind pattern that brings with it huge rainfall
land-locked country	a country that isn't connected to any ocean or sea

The Royal Charter

- There are 7 continents and 5 oceans in the world.
