Subject Specific Vocabulary

Continent	The number of people living in an area.
Physical features	Natural environment of an area .E.g water, soil and trees
Human features	The changes humans have made to an area. E.g buildings, road and houses
Country	A nation with its own government, occupying a particular territory. E.g United Kingdom
Landmarks	An object or feature of a landscape or town that is easily seen and recognized from a distance, especially one that enables someone to establish their location E.g Beetham tower
Atlas	The maps are used by people walking in the country, and each map has its own OS number
Equator	An imaginary line going around the centre of the Earth at equal distance from the North and South pole.
Weather	The day to day conditions of an area e.g. rainy, sunny, thunderstorms.
Climate	The average of the weather over a period of 30 years or more.
