<b>Reception</b>	<b>My Wonderful World</b>  My Wonderful World is a topic that supports children as they begin their Reception journey by exploring their interests, identities, emotions, and where they live. Through high-quality texts and child-led learning, children will reflect on what makes them unique while developing respect for others and curiosity about the wider world. This topic promotes equity by celebrating every child's background and ensuring all voices and experiences are valued in the classroom. Learning will be shaped by children's own ideas, helping them feel seen, heard, and included from the very start.  *There will be a whole	<b>Twinkle, Glow and Shine</b>  Twinkle, Glow and Shine is a topic that encourages children to explore light, space, and seasonal celebrations through high-quality texts and imaginative experiences. Children will learn about Earth and its place in space, while developing an early understanding of sustainability and how to care for the planet. Through festivals, stories, and creative expression, they will explore how light brings comfort, connection, and joy.  This topic promotes curiosity, confidence, and a strong sense of belonging as children begin to shine in their own unique ways.	<b>Everyday Heroes</b>  Everyday Heroes is a topic that inspires children to recognise the power of kindness, bravery, and helping others through high-quality texts and meaningful experiences. Children will explore the roles of real-life community helpers, while also celebrating the everyday acts of courage and care found in themselves and their peers. Through stories, imaginative play, and creative expression, they will learn that anyone can be a hero, no matter how small. This topic encourages aspiration, empathy, and a growing sense of self-belief as children discover the superpowers within.	<b>Bloom and Grow</b>  Bloom and Grow is a topic that nurtures children's understanding of the natural world through high-quality texts and hands-on experiences. Children will explore the life cycles of both plants and animals, observing how seeds grow into flowers and how birds and frogs develop and change as they grow. Through stories, outdoor exploration, and eco-focused activities, they will begin to understand the importance of sustainability and how to care for the world around them. This topic encourages curiosity, responsibility, and a deep appreciation for nature as children bloom in confidence and grow in knowledge.	<b>Together We Belong</b>  Together We Belong is a topic that celebrates identity, diversity, and inclusion through high-quality texts and imaginative storytelling. Children will explore the warmth and connection of family life in So Much and the courage and teamwork of The Night Pirates, learning that families can look different but all offer care, support, and belonging. Through role play, discussion, and creative experiences, they will explore themes of equity, representation, and fairness — recognising that everyone has the right to be seen, heard, and valued. This topic promotes respect,	<b>Paws, Claws and Rhyming Jaws</b>  Paws, Claws and Rhyming Jaws is a fun and imaginative topic that explores pets, pond life, and under-the-sea creatures through the rhyming worlds of Hairy Maclary and Oi Frog! Children will develop their phonological awareness through playful language, rhyming patterns, and playful storytelling, while also learning about rules, responsibility, and caring for animals. Through creative role play and exploration of land and water habitats, they will discover how to care for living things and begin to understand the importance of protecting our
