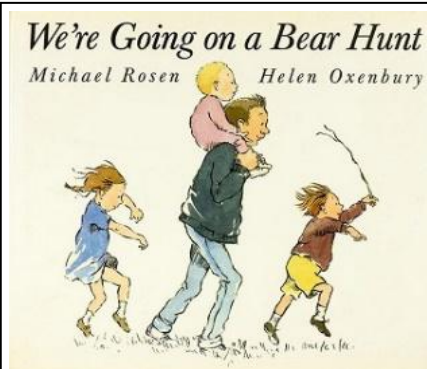


This week in Reception

Phonics:

In Phonics, we will be applying long vowel phonemes to the reading and spelling of words such as joint, boast, spark, growl, groan, speech, steep, float, flight. We will be exploring the meaning of the words. We will say the following sentence 3 times, and count the words. We will segment the sounds in the words and write the sentence using cursive letter formation: 'I like toast with jam.'

What we are learning:

We are starting a new topic about journeys and to begin the topic we are sharing our own experiences of going on a journey and different modes of transport.

In Literacy, we are sharing the story of 'We're going on a bear hunt.' On this journey, the family are travelling on foot. We will be thinking about the journeys that the children do on foot and their outside experiences. We will be devising our own actions as we share the book together and answering comprehension questions in full sentences. We will be writing our own versions of the story and making story maps.

In maths, we will be sharing numbers into groups of an equal size and focusing on spatial awareness by building models.
