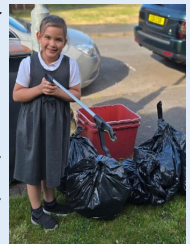

Biodegradability

All types of litter take time to degrade, so the ideal thing is not to drop it in the first place. Here is the average time it takes for some commonly discarded litter to decompose. **Orange peel and banana skins** - up to 2 years, **Cigarette butts** - up to 2 years, **Plastic bags** -10-20 years, **Tin cans** - 50 years, **Aluminium cans** - 80-100 years, **Plastic bottles** – they can last forever, **Glass** – does not degrade

Katherine (made famous in the film *Hidden Figures*) made American society change its blinkered views towards race and helped humankind land on the moon in 1969.
