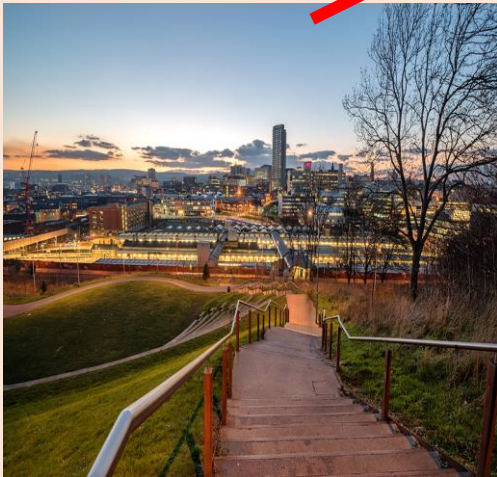


## Scarborough



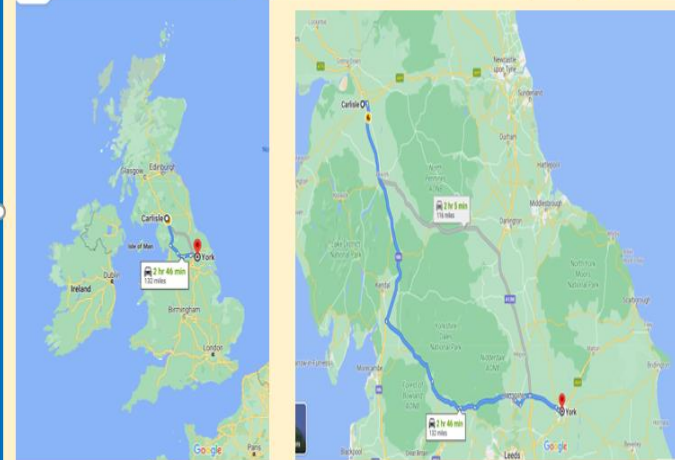
