Art with Becca

Art with Becca is a vibrant visual arts club where children experiment with a wide range of media, including watercolours, pencils, oil pastels, and more. Each session encourages exploration, creativity, and self-expression through engaging projects designed to develop artistic skills and imagination.

Bob's Pottery Club

Led by a skilled local potter, Bob's Pottery Club offers children the chance to explore clay work in a hands-on, creative environment. Each week, participants complete a unique clay project, which is then dried, kiln-fired, and returned for decorating. This club nurtures artistic confidence and introduces children to the full ceramic process from concept to completion.



Year 5 Arts Residential: Ingestre Hall

Every Year 5 child has the opportunity to attend a residential arts experience at Ingestre Hall in Stafford. During this immersive week, children select a specialist art form, such as visual art or animation, and work intensively on a personal project. The week culminates in a showcase where children present their creations to their peers, celebrating their artistic journey and achievements.

We actively seek opportunities for children to participate in local art events. A highlight is the annual local council Christmas card design competition, which many of our pupils enter. The winning design is featured on the council's official Christmas card, offering children a chance to see their artwork celebrated in the wider community.
