Year 6	Areas of Study-
<i>Listening</i>	Listen and show understanding of more complex sentences containing familiar and unfamiliar words
<i>Speaking</i>	Engage in a short conversation using familiar questions and express opinions Pronounce unfamiliar words in a sentence using knowledge of letter strings, liaison and silent letter rules
<i>Reading</i>	Read aloud the text of familiar rhymes and songs Understand the gist of an unfamiliar text using some familiar language Read and show understanding of a series of complex sentences using familiar language Decode a simple unfamiliar text using grammatical knowledge, context or a bi-lingual dictionary
<i>Writing</i>	Write and say a complex sentence manipulating familiar language, using a dictionary for new language Write complex sentences from memory manipulating familiar vocabulary with understandable accuracy
<i>Language Learning Strategies</i>	Manipulate familiar language to present own ideas and information in more complex sentences Use the correct form of the definite article in singular and plural sentences Apply all grammatical knowledge learnt to build complex sentences
<i>The Francophone World and Intercultural Understanding</i>	Respect and understand cultural diversity. Appreciate stories, songs, poems and rhymes in the language
