Forest School—Early Years



At Forest School we learnt about some of the different plants that are edible and growing at the moment. We don't have many wild edible plants on our school grounds at the moment but we did find daisies and dandelions (we didn't taste these today) and lemon sorrel growing at school, and we looked at some wild garlic, chickweed and hawthorn found growing locally. We chatted about how you should never pick a plant and eat it unless a grown up has said it's ok to. We made wild garlic pesto and tried it over pasta. Some children loved it and went back for seconds and others did not like it!

We also explored making different shades of green to paint our clay Green Man from last week. Watch out for our Green Man when it's hung on the outdoor classroom!
