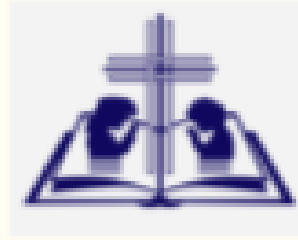
Safeguarding at Sacred Heart Catholic Primary School

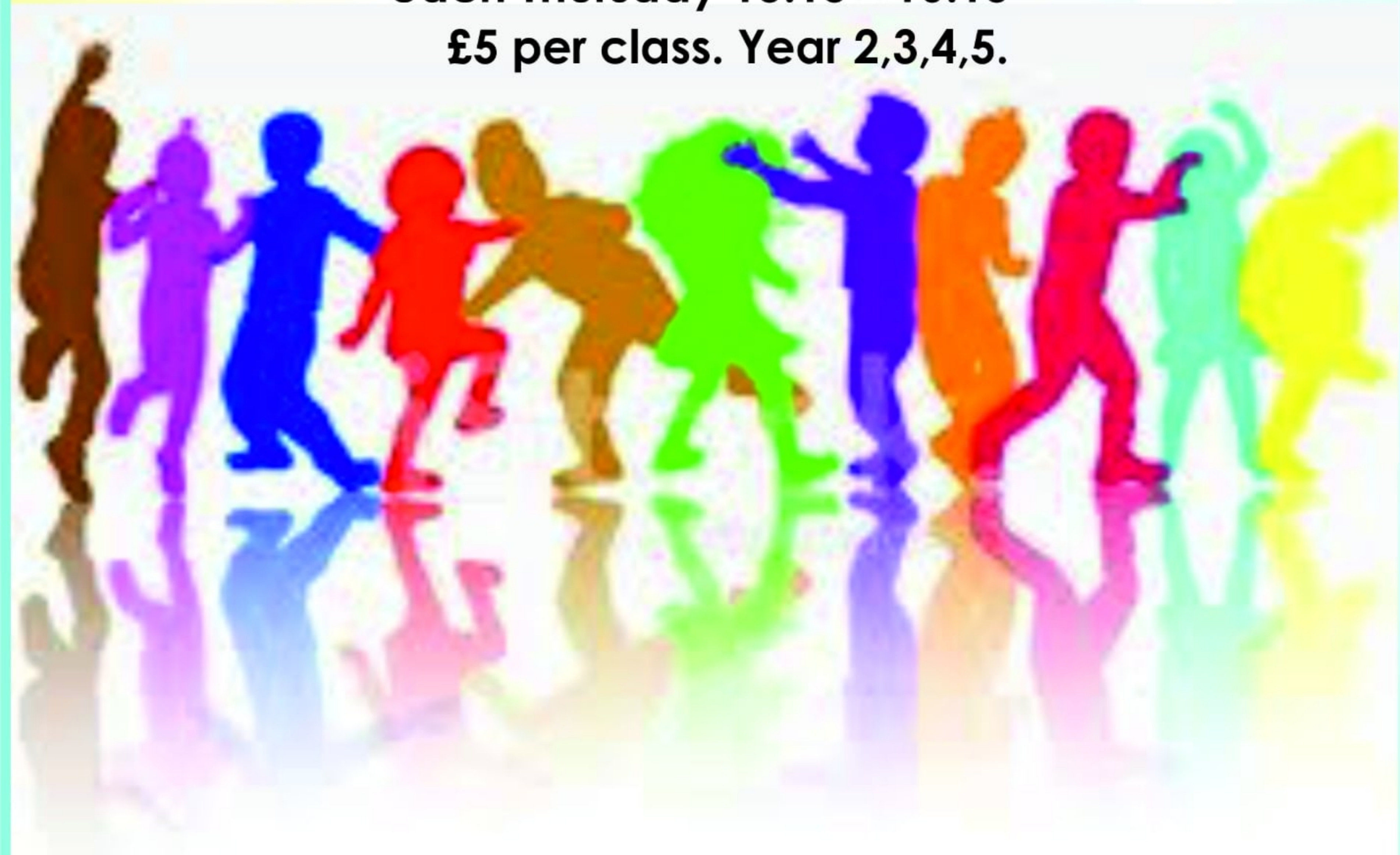
