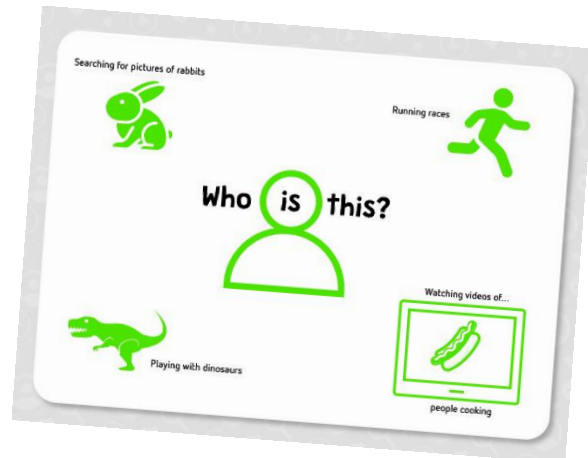
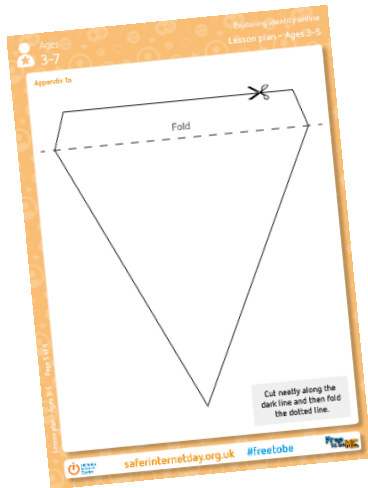

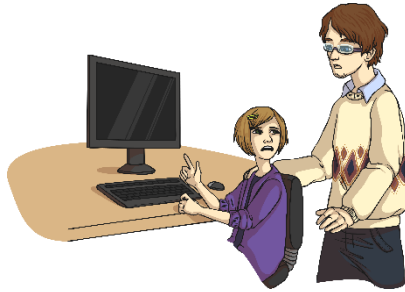
What Do You Use the Internet For?

- In our real lives, it provides us with entertainment, allows us to communicate and helps us learn new things.

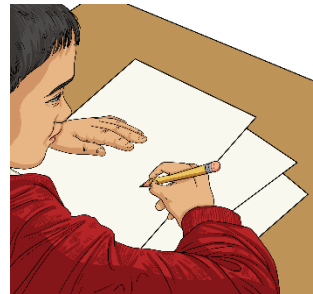

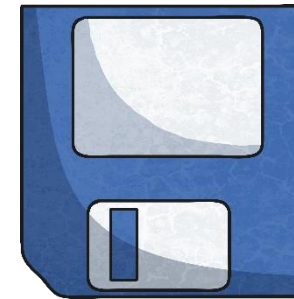

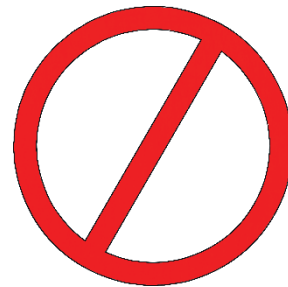

SECRET Keep your personal details to yourself

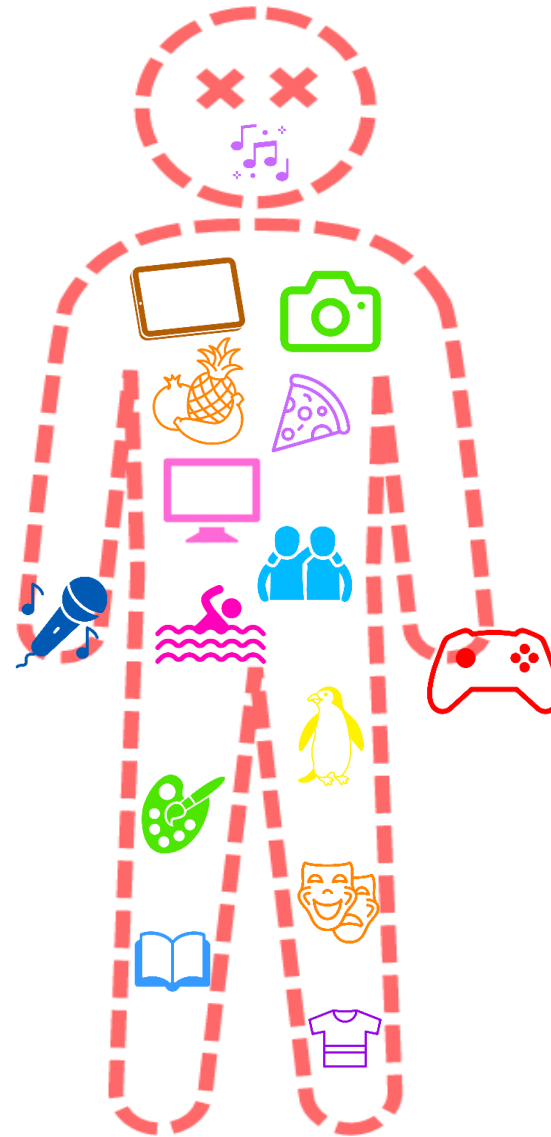
MEETING Remember, you should never meet someone you have met on the internet without your parents' permission

What Is Your Online Identity?

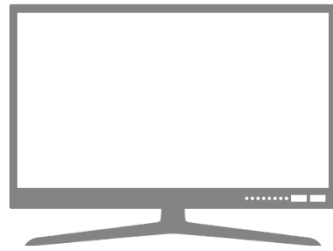
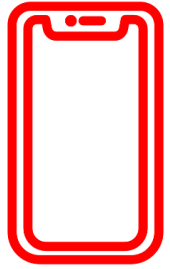
- When we go online, we have an online identity.

Digital Footprints



A **digital footprint** is a funny term used to describe the traces of yourself that you leave online. It's called a **footprint** because, with every website you visit, you leave a trail or **footprint** showing that you've been there - much like the **footprints** you leave while playing outside in the snow.
