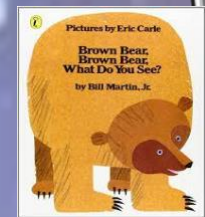
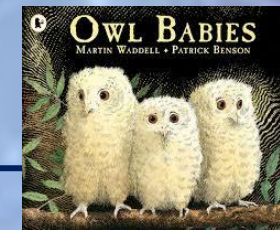
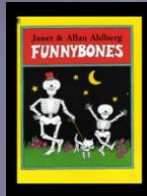
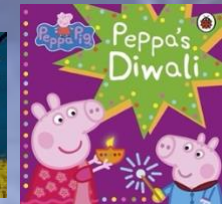
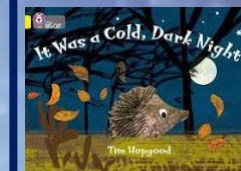
### The Royal Charter of Facts

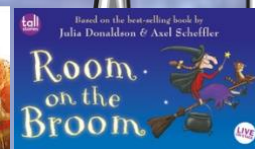

### Subject Specific Vocabulary

Season	Each year we have four seasons that our planet experiences which are autumn, winter, spring and summer.
Leaves	Leaves are grown on trees, and they change colour and texture during Autumn.
Conkers	Conkers are a hard, shiny, and brown nut from a chestnut tree.
Acorns	Acorns are nuts from an oak tree, and they have a hard shell that is cupped shape at the top.
Squirrel	Squirrels eat nuts and have furry skin with a bushy tail.
Hedgehog	Hedgehogs are small creatures with spikey skin and a pointy nose.
Hibernate	Hibernate is when animals sleep for a very long time in the colder seasons.
Owl	An owl has two big circular eyes and a small beak and stays high up in trees. Owls come out at nighttime.
Chilly	The weather is really cold outside, or a person can describe how they feel.
Frost	When it is very cold, ice covers the outdoors.
Fog/mist	This happens when it is very cold outside and you can not see the environment.
