Following on from my recent letter regarding the sad passing of our dear colleague, Deb. As you are aware, Deb was an incredibly important part of the Leverton Primary School community, and her loss has left a deep impact on all of us.

Many members of staff would like to attend her funeral to pay their respects, and we are currently exploring ways to balance this with ensuring the safety and well-being of the children in our care. We fully understand that some parents may have work commitments, and we are committed to making this process as smooth as possible for everyone.

On Thursday, 25th September, we would like to offer the opportunity for parents to pick up their children between 1:30 pm and 2:00 pm. This would help us ensure that staff can attend the service, while also keeping school operations as unaffected as possible. However, we fully understand that not all parents may be able to pick up their children during this time. If you are able to do so, we would be most grateful, but if your child needs to remain at school, we will make the necessary arrangements to ensure they are cared for.

Some members of staff, including a number of teachers and teaching assistants, will not be attending the funeral and will be staying at school to provide full support for the children who remain.

We sincerely appreciate the understanding and kind comments many of you have shared with us during this difficult time. Your continued support means a great deal to the staff and children here at Leverton.

Going Home Arrangements


