What Are the Levels of Help?
Everyday Help (OAIP) – small changes in class
★ SEND Support – more help like small groups
EHCP – a full plan made by the Local Authority if you need lots of support

Learning: Reading, writing, numbers, understanding

Feelings: ADHD, anxiety, anger, friendships
