Subject Specific Vocabulary

Population	The number of people living in an area.
Physical features	Natural environment of an area .E.g water, soil and trees
Human features	The changes humans have made to an area. E.g buildings, road and houses
Country	A nation with its own government, occupying a particular territory. E.g United Kingdom
County	A territorial division of some countries such as Lancashire.
Landmarks	An object or feature of a landscape or town that is easily seen and recognized from a distance, especially one that enables someone to establish their location E.g Beatham tower
Route	A way taken to get from a starting point to a destination.
Town	A built-up area with a name, that is larger than a village and generally smaller than a city. E. g Stockport
Village	A small group of houses and associated buildings situated in a rural area. E.g Styal
Ordnance Survey	The maps are used by people walking in the country, and each map has its own OS number
City	A large town
