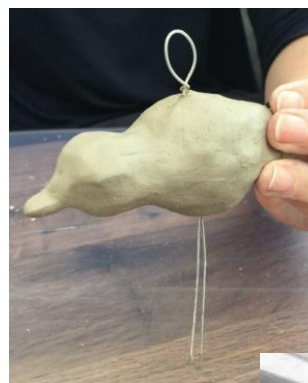


Key Vocabulary

Key Word	Definition
Sketchbooks	A book with blank pages for sketching used by artists for drawing or painting as a part of their creative process.
Response	The feeling that a work of art provokes in you, or how your own work of art responds to an idea or issue.
Clay	A type of soil that's made of very small particles. You can mould clay into different shapes when it's wet.
Construct	Putting basic shapes together to form a more complex shape or object.
Model	The creation of a 3-dimensional piece of art typically using some type of clay.
Collage	The artistic process of gluing and assembling various materials to a surface.
Paper Crafting	Using paper or card to create two or three-dimensional objects.
