Phonics:

In Phonics this week we will be revisiting the digraphs and trigraphs that we have been learning this term and continue to apply them to longer words ai, igh, oa, ee, ur, oo/oo, oi, er, ow, ear, air.

We will be reading and writing the following sentences: The cat has a ribbon on its tail; He has loads of carrots in his bucket; The duck got in the boat - quack!


We will be revisiting the 'tricky' words: was, they, you, my, by, all, are, sure & pure and practising spelling them.

What we are learning:

This half term, we are learning through the topic of Superheroes with a focus on Personal, Social & Emotional Development. We will be looking at the qualities of real-life superheroes such as nurses, doctors, firefighters and many others.

In Literacy, we are sharing the story of The Evil Pea in 'Supertato' and exploring new vocabulary and retelling the story. We will be writing sentences working on using story language and segmenting sounds. We will be exploring different types of characters.

In maths, we will be working on solving problems by counting on and counting back from numbers. We will be using the part part whole method to explore the composition of numbers.



At home

Select a word with double letters such as rabbit, rubber, hammer or shimmer. Compose your own sentence and say the sentence 3 times out loud then count the words. For example, The rabbit had long, black ears. Segment and stretch out the sounds in words writing them in the order you hear them. Remember to leave a space between each word and read back your sentence.
